

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which GravelanD.pl collects, uses, maintains and discloses information collected from users (each, a "User") of the GravelanD.pl website ("Site"). This privacy policy applies to the Site and all products and services offered by GravelanD.pl

Personal identification information

We may collect personal identification information from Users in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, when Users visit our site, register on the site, place an order, fill out a form respond to a survey and in connection with other activities, services, features or resources we make available on our Site. Users may be asked for, as appropriate, email address.

Users may, however, visit our Site anonymously.

We will collect personal identification information from Users only if they voluntarily submit such information to us. Users can always refuse to supply personally identification information, except that it may prevent them from engaging in certain Site related activities.

Non-personal identification information

We may collect non-personal identification information about Users whenever they interact with our Site. Non-personal identification information may include the browser name, the type of computer and technical information about Users means of connection to our Site, such as the operating system and the Internet service providers utilized and other similar information.

Web browser cookies

Our Site may use "cookies" to enhance User experience. User's web browser places cookies on their hard drive for record-keeping purposes and sometimes to track information about them. User may choose to set their web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert You when cookies are being sent. If they do so, note that some parts of the Site may not function properly.

How we use collected information

GravelanD.pl collects and uses Users personal information for the following purposes:

To improve customer service

Your information helps us to more effectively respond to your customer service requests and support needs.

To personalize user experience

We may use information in the aggregate to understand how our Users as a group use the services and resources provided on our Site.

To improve our Site

We continually strive to improve our website offerings based on the information and feedback we receive from You.

To process transactions to the extent necessary to and the implementation of concluded contracts via the Site; We may use the information Users provide about themselves when placing an order only to provide service to that order. We do not share this information with outside parties except to the extent necessary to provide the service to carry out orders placed by the Users in regard to the products in the online offer of GravelanD.pl; for the purpose of complaints registration, and the potential refund in case of termination of the contract (returning the goods);

Providing personal data is voluntary however, declining the request to process the data may prevent us from providing the User with the electronic services and may prevent the User from being able to conduct online purchases via the Site.

To administer a content, promotion, survey or other Site feature.

To send Users information they agreed to receive about topics we think will be of interest to them.

To send periodic emails

The email address Users provide for order processing, will only be used to send them information and updates pertaining to their order. It may also be used to respond to their inquiries, and/or other requests or questions. If User decides to opt-in to our mailing list, they will receive emails that may include company news, updates, related product or service information, etc. If at any time the User would like to unsubscribe from receiving future emails, we include detailed unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of each email or User may contact us via our Site.

Server Logs

Information about some of the actions of the Users are stored in the logging layer of the server. This data is used only to administer the Site and to provide the most efficient Site hosting services.

The accessed resources are identified by URLs. In addition, the stored data may include:

date of the query,

time of response,

the name of the client station - identification carried out by the HTTP protocol,

information about errors that have occurred in the implementation of the HTTP transaction,

URL of the site previously visited by the User (referrer link) – in case there has been a redirection to the Site by a referer link,

information on the User's browser,

IP address information.

The figures are disassociated with the individual persons browsing the Site.

The above data are used only for the purposes of administering the server.

Entrusting us with their personal information, the User has the right to access them, the right to demand updates and to request their removal. Personal data provided by the User can be edited or deleted by the User himself. How we protect your information

We adopt appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or destruction of your personal information, username, password, transaction information and data stored on our Site.

Sensitive and private data exchange between the Site and its Users happens over a SSL secured communication channel and is encrypted and protected with digital signatures.

We disclose potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information (Nickname or E-mail) only to those of its employees, vendors and affiliated organizations that:

need to know that information in order to process it on our behalf or to provide services available at our website, and

that have agreed not to disclose it to others.

We disclose potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when we believe in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of us, third parties or the public at large.

Some of those employees, vendors and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using our website, you consent to the transfer of such information to them.

We will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone.

If you send us a request (for example via a support email or via one of our feedback mechanisms), we reserve the right to publish it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users. We take all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

All gathered data, in the manner described above, are stored in the Personal Database belonging to GravelanD.pl

The database and IT system, in which it is stored, is subject to special protection through technical and organizational measures which should be fulfilled by devices and systems used for the processing of personal Data.

GravelanD.pl applies security measures at the highest level specified in this Regulation.

GravelanD.pl ensures, that additionally to the aforementioned technical and organizational security measures, we strictly comply with all regulations and standards for the protection of the Users' personal data by preventing unauthorized processing of data and accidental loss, deletion or any other form of damage. GravelanD.pl also ensures that the access to the database is restricted to the persons explicitly authorized by the data administrator.

Third party websites

Users may find advertising or other content on our Site that link to the sites and services of our partners, suppliers, advertisers, sponsors, licensors and other third parties. We do not control the content or links that appear on these sites and are not responsible for the practices employed by websites linked to or from our Site. Compliance with children's online privacy protection act

Protecting the privacy of the very young is especially important. For that reason, we never collect or maintain information at our Site from those we actually know are under 13, and no part of our website is structured to attract anyone under 13.
